At Force Elementary we believe: That uniforms will help us improve the overall safety of our school. We want to better distinguish our students from other school-age students who do not belong on our campus. Additionally, we want our students to take pride of their school by wearing their Force Elementary gear.

Wearing uniforms will not be optional at Force Elementary School. All students will be required to wear uniforms every day. We welcome parents, guardians, and community members to purchase items for themselves as well. Go Roadrunners!

Appropriate Dress For School

Uniform Shirts

Color: Navy Blue with the Force Elementary logo

Style: Knit polo shirt with a collar, short sleeves or long sleeve t-shirt

Logos or designs other than the Force Elementary logo are not allowed on the shirts. Shirts should be tucked in. Students may wear sweatshirts that have the school logo on them. The shirt is acceptable with or without the school's logo, but it must be plain (Navy Blue). On Fridays, students may wear blue jeans with either their pink or gray Force t-shirt.

Uniform Pants

Color: Khaki (Monday – Thursday), Blue or Black Jeans (Fridays)

Style: Chino pants, shorts, skirt, skort, capris or jumper

Pants should be straight legged must fit comfortably; they should not be tight or baggy. No styles of bell-bottoms or flares are allowed. Pants should be worn at the waist and skirts, skorts and jumpers must be knee length; no mini-skirts. During the cold winter months, students are allowed to wear a solid color long sleeve shirt under their Force Elementary shirt.

To ensure that the school's uniform policy has the desired effect, it is important that it be implemented consistently. School leaders, faculty and staff will do their best to respond immediately to violations of the policy. Force Elementary families are expected to support the school when out-of-uniform issues arise. The family will be expected to bring the child what is needed, or the child will not be allowed to return to class. If you need assistance purchasing these items, please contact Jenny Marx our school's counselor.
